The full-time USAG Competitive Team Program Director at New Heights Gymnastics is responsible for building strong relationships with competitive team gymnasts, parents, and staff and fostering an environment of success. Through these important relationships, our Program Director is able to provide the highest quality gymnastics program to our community in an endeavor to achieve competitive gymnastics success while fostering healthy relationships for athletes and parents.

Tasks and Responsibilities *

- Demonstrate highly effective and energetic coaching tactics and strategies.
- Create and distribute lesson plans for team program instruction.
- Daily coaching and regular formal evaluation of USAG team and training-team/dev-group gymnasts.
- Develop strong and caring professional relationships with children, parents, and co-workers.
- Communicate effectively and professionally with coworkers, parents, gymnasts and gym owners.
- Follow established communication protocol to solve problems.
- Communicate gymnasts' progress regularly with coaching staff, management, and parents/guardians.
- Communicate gymnast's progress with other coaches when making decisions and recommending for placement.
- Be aware and abide by all safety precautions and rules while coaching.
- Communicate safety precautions and safety messages with gymnasts, parents, and co-workers on a regular basis.
- Be on time to all practices and for all scheduled work hours.
- Attend and participate in staff education, professional development, learning observations, and related opportunities.
- Oversee year-round team program coaching staff in-service education.
- Complete daily program paperwork; employment paperwork, evaluations, student birthday cards, etc.
- Wear appropriate attire and footwear and maintain a professional appearance at all times.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and give 100% effort in all areas required for the position.
- Be knowledgeable about NHGM programs and help inform and market program offerings.
- Help plan, and attend, all scheduled competitions and camps.

Minimum Qualifications

- 5+ years of full-time USAG competitive gymnastics coaching experience, or equivalent
- Mastery level knowledge of requirements of the USAG program and team level placement, training group design, and development of lesson plans in order to progress gymnasts safely and effectively.
- Must pass and maintain a clear criminal background check
- Hold a valid and clear USAG membership and maintain all required certifications
- Must be proficient in computer skills (Word, Excel, Power Point, iClass/customer management)
- Must be highly organized, high energy, and have a passion for the sport of gymnastics.
- Commitment to long-term professional development and continuing education
- Love for working with kids in a safe and professional environment
- CPR & First-Aid certification

Ideal Qualifications

- 5+ years of full-time USAG competitive gymnastics team program management experience
- Bachelor's or Master's degree in relevant area (business, exercise science, coaching, etc.)

Working Conditions

- Potential exposure to hazardous material/bodily fluids including but not limited to magnesium carbonate (chalk), blood, urine, and vomit (our customers are children).
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Active on feet for more than 4 hours at a time.
- May be required to administer life saving measures to gymnasts, customers or staff
- Other (This is not an exhaustive list of potentially hazardous working conditions.)

Employee Evaluations

Every employee at New Heights Gymnastics & More will be evaluated at least yearly and more frequently as needed based upon the length of time employed and performance. Employees may also receive other forms of evaluation, including but not limited to formal and informal observations. Your first evaluation will be held after your 3-month introductory period of employment.
